GHS and CLP services

As a global company Royal Haskoning offers regulatory services related to the Global Harmonised System (GHS) of Classification and Labelling of Chemicals. In particular, we offer services related the EU implementation of GHS: the CLP regulation.

Based on discussions with chemical companies and branch organisations, it is anticipated that the effort by the chemical industry, necessary to comply with GHS, is even larger than the effort for REACH. GHS has not only consequences for the Material Safety Data Sheets of companies, but indirectly affects other legislative obligations, like transport legislation. Global Notifications

Several regulatory regimes in the world enforce submission of notification dossiers before new chemicals can be placed on the market, similar to the REACH registration obligation.

Whereas classification & labeling criteria are moving towards global harmonization through GHS, the information requirements of the ten existing schemes vary considerably in terms of the data to be supplied and the risk assessment. Doing business on global markets remains challenging and delay or disruption of market access is a potential, but realistic risk.

Therefore, careful planning of new chemicals notifications is of key importance. To support companies, Royal Haskoning offers a range of services ranging from strategic planning of test programs and registration strategies to complete dossier preparation and submission.
